
# 中3英語 前期期末試験対策5

Now we usually go to the store by bike. We always bring our own bags. We don't ask for chopsticks or plastic bags at the store. Thanks to Rachel, we started to change our lives, but I still have a question about chopsticks.

Some people say that we don't \*damage the forests because we use \*remnants of wood to make chopsticks. Is that true? I asked Father about it. He said, "I have no idea, but I've heard this." Many people have started carrying their own chopsticks."

"Silent spring" means "a spring without life," Rachel Carson said. I like spring very much. I enjoy beautiful green leaves and the songs of birds. I can feel life. I can feel nature. We should try to protect our nature. We don't have to do big things. Let's do little things for the Earth. If each of us makes small changes, we can save the Earth. If we can save the Earth, it will be a better place for our children. Let's start now.
