


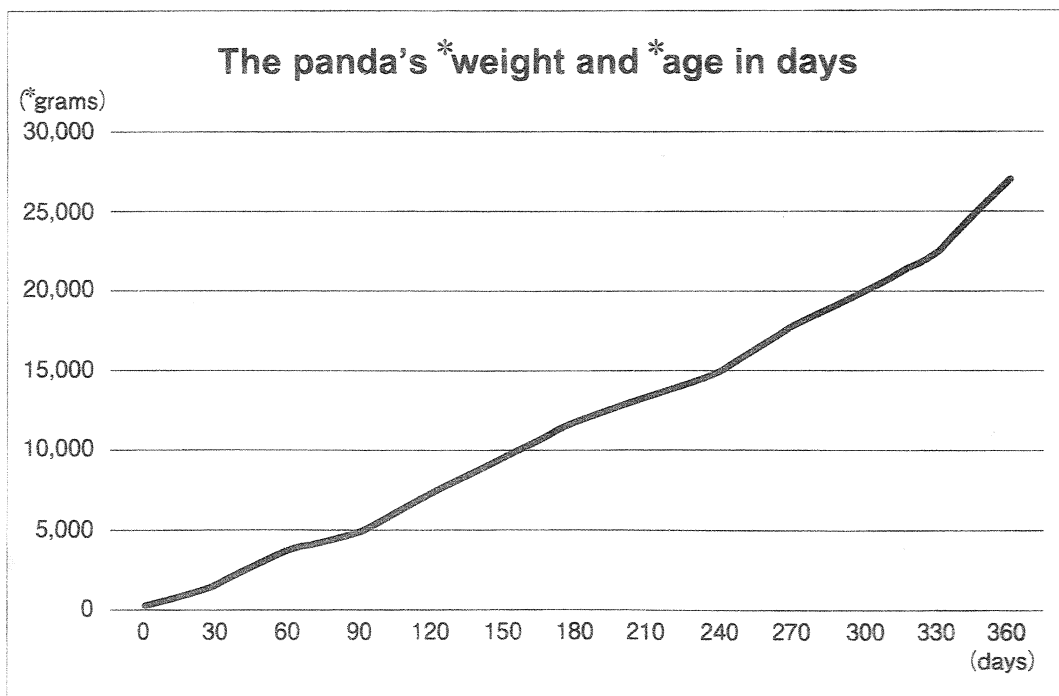
Hello, everyone. I am Miki. I love animals, and \*pandas are my favorite of all. I have learned so much about pandas. I want to talk about that today.

Pandas are \*originally from \*China. They have white \*fur around their head and body. Also they have black fur around their legs \*as well as around their ears and eyes. I think pandas look very cute because of this white and black fur.

I have been to a zoo in Shirahama, Wakayama to see pandas before. The zoo keeps some pandas. I saw a small panda that day. ( ① ) One of the \*zookeepers told me that the panda was a \*female, and that she was seven months old. The zookeeper also said to me, “She began to climb a tree a week ago.” It took a little time for the little panda to climb the tree, but she finally \*reached the first \*branch. I was so happy to see that. Then I suddenly wanted to know, “How do pandas \*grow up?” I went to the library and borrowed some books about pandas. I also used the Internet to get more information about them.

It shows the weight and age in days for a female panda. The panda in the zoo in Shirahama, Wakayama was seven months old, so . From my study, I learned that pandas are only 200 grams when they are born. I was so surprised to know that. Pandas usually open their eyes for the first time when they become 50 days old. They begin to walk when they become 100 days old. I think most people know that pandas love to eat \*bamboo

leaves. Bamboo leaves are still a little hard for pandas to eat when they are babies. Pandas usually begin to eat them when they are about one year old. ( ② )

Pandas are one of the most popular animals in zoos. \*While I was doing my study, I learned that pandas are on the \*Red List. The \*population of the animals that are on the list is \*decreasing. One of the reasons is \*environmental change. Pandas live only in \*limited woods, and 99 % of their food is bamboo leaves. To \*protect the population of pandas, we must protect the environment. ( ③ ) \*As a result, the population of pandas \*increased \*by 17 % between 2004 and 2014. I hope I can do something for pandas. I will keep learning about pandas and \*try my best to be \*helpful for them. Thank you for listening.
