リスニングテスト放送内容

問題は(ア)・(イ)・(ウ)の三つに大きく分かれています。放送を聞きながらメモをとってもかまいません。

それでは、問題(ア)に入ります。問題(ア)は、No.1～No.3まであります。TerryとMegumiが話をしています。まずTerryが話し、次にMegumiが話し、その後も交互に話します。対話の最後でMegumiが話す言葉のかわりに(チャイムの音)というチャイムが鳴ります。そのチャイムのところに入るMegumiの言葉として最も適するものを、問題(ア)の指示にしたがって答えなさい。まず、問題(ア)の指示を読みなさい。[間 7 秒] それでは、始めます。対話は2回ずつ放送します。

No.1 [Terry :] Good morning, Megumi. Oh, you look sleepy.

[Megumi :] Yes. I went to bed at one o'clock in the morning.

[Terry :] That's late. Were you studying?

No.2 [Terry :] What are you reading, Megumi?

[Megumi :] I'm reading a comic book about Japanese history.

[Terry :] That sounds interesting. I'm interested in Japanese history, so I want to read it.

No.3 [Terry :] Megumi, I found this dictionary at the school library. Someone's name is written on it, but I cannot read the name.

[Megumi :] Well, I think this is the name of a Chinese student. I don't know how to read this name. Is there anyone who can read Chinese?

[Terry :] I think Mr. Suzuki can. He is my history teacher.

[Kenji :] Of course. We can take pictures with them. Do you want to come with me, Monica?

[Monica :] I want to, but I have to go home to cook lunch for my family. Please tell me about the event tomorrow.

[Kenji :] OK, I will. See you.

No.2 [Monica :] Our winter vacation will start soon. What are you going to do, Kenji?

[Kenji :] I'm going to visit Nara with my family. Nara is famous for a lot of old temples. How about you, Monica?

[Monica :] My brother in London will come to see me. He is interested in Japanese culture, so I want to go for *hatsumode* with him on January 1.

[Kenji :] That's nice. I want to see your brother. Please come to my house to eat *osechi ryori* after *hatsumode*. *Osechi ryori* is a traditional Japanese dish eaten on some days of the new year. My mother cooks it every year.

[Monica :] Oh, can we? Thanks, Kenji. We will come to your house.

[Kenji :] OK. I hope you'll enjoy eating *osechi ryori*.
