





<最初の英文>



問6 次の英文は、高校生のカオリ(Kaori)が英語の授業でクラスの生徒に向けて行った発表の原稿です。英文を読んで、あとの(ア)~(ウ)の問いに答えなさい。

Hi, I'm Kaori. I met a girl from *Thailand at my *aunt's house last week. She has stayed at my aunt's house *since January. Her name is Mali, and she came to Japan to study Japanese. She can speak English, too. So we talked in Japanese and English. I said to her that her Japanese was great. (①) I *asked her how she started learning Japanese. She *answered that her brother *introduced her to the Japanese language. He was studying Japanese at *college in Thailand. (②) She started to think that she wanted to learn the Japanese *culture through her *own eyes after watching them. So, she *decided to come to Japan to *experience the *different cultures.

After I met Mali, I started thinking about "experiencing the different cultures" *for the first time. I like studying English and I want to speak it well. Reading books and watching TV programs and movies in English are good, but I always thought that I needed to do more to *be able to get better at speaking. (③) I *realized that I needed to learn things through my own eyes. I want to learn English *abroad to learn different cultures. I started to *look up *information on the Internet. Please look at *Graph.

It shows many Japanese students went to America to study English. *As you can see, many students went to Australia to study, too. My mother has told me that she studied at college there. I think Australia has been a popular country for studying English for a long time. I hear the Philippines is becoming popular *these days.

Next, I decided to look up schools in America, England, Canada, and New Zealand. I also tried to get information about *costs. I think the *main costs are *tuition, *housing cost, and food cost. Please look at *Table. It shows the *average tuition, housing cost, and food cost for *each country for a year *in Japanese yen.

We can know that the tuition for a year *among the four countries is about the *same. The *difference in the food cost among the four countries is 170,000 yen. The food cost in New Zealand is the *lowest of the four. The food cost in England and Canada is higher than the food cost in America. And there is a difference of 260,000 yen in the housing cost *between England and New Zealand. In New Zealand, there are *cheaper places to live in, I think.

Also, you can *share your *living space with other students. I think you can learn a lot from other students, so I *am interested in doing that.

Yesterday, I met Mali at my aunt's house again. I told her about the things I looked up. She said that she did the same thing before coming to Japan, too. She looked up the food cost and the housing cost in different *prefectures in Japan. She said the *websites of schools also had housing information. I thanked Mali for telling me her *story. Her story and experience were *helpful to me.

I'm going to decide which country to study English. Then I will start *saving up. I also want to go to Thailand *one day. I'm glad that I had a *chance to think about studying English because I could talk with Mali. I think being able to speak English is great because we can talk with many people in the world.
