Report

Mother Teresa was born in *Macedonia in 1910. She wanted to give her life to *God when she was very young. She became a *nun when she was 18.

She went to India in 1929. At first, her job was teaching girls in high school. When she saw poor people on the street, she couldn't forget them and wanted to help them. Mother Teresa taught children in the *slums *even though there were no desks and no chairs. She also took care of many hungry and sick people.

She *founded "*Missionaries of Charity" to help more poor and sick people in the world. About thirty years after she started, in 1979, she received the *Nobel Peace Prize. At the *ceremony, she said, "Love begins at home. Smile at each other. Help each other. Then, more and more love will grow." The *prize money was used to help poor people in India.
