



問 6 次の英文は、高校生のリョウタ(Ryota)が参加した語学研修を通して学んだことについて、 英語の授業で行った発表の原稿です。英文を読んで、あとの(ア)~(ウ)の問いに答えなさい。

Hello, everyone. I am Ryota. Do you want to study in a foreign country? In 2011, about 3,300 high school students studied in foreign countries for more than three months. There are more than 5,000 high schools in Japan, so *per high school, there was *less than one student. Some people may think high school students aren't interested in studying in foreign countries.

Now, please look at the *graphs. In a *survey, about 2,500 high school students answered some questions, and these graphs show the *percentages of their answers. When you look at these graphs, you can say that about 57% of the students said they were interested in studying in a foreign country, and about 76% said they (①). I was surprised to learn there were many high school students who were interested in foreign cultures and the lives of foreign people. And more than half of the students (②), like me! When we study in foreign countries, everything around us looks new, and I think we will sometimes experience difficult things. But if we are interested in different cultures and people in those countries, I think it will be easy for us to be friends with people we meet there.





Last July, I visited a city in Australia with a teacher and ten students from my high school. Look at the *schedule. They studied English hard in the class. They spoke only in English to the teachers. So, like them, I tried to use only English, too. From now, when I study a foreign language, I'll try to speak it without being afraid of making *mistakes. I learned that from those students.

When I talked with them, I found that there were many differences among them. For example, they spoke different languages. They had different *eating habits. They thought in different ways, too. I sometimes felt *puzzled, but those differences were always interesting to me. So, I asked them about their lives in their countries. They also asked me many questions about life in Japan. It was sometimes difficult for me to answer their questions. But I was happy to find they (③). And now I'd like to learn more about Japan.

After I came back to Japan, I had a *chance to listen to a speech by a man from India. He really enjoys living in different cultures. He came to Japan after studying for four years in America. Now he lives in a small *village in Japan and teaches English to the children there. Some people ask him why he lives in such a small village, but he is really happy to live there. He loves the beautiful nature and the kind people there. People in that village take care of him when he is sick. They give him vegetables in each season. Sometimes he cooks food for the people living there by using the vegetables they have given him. The children he teaches enjoy eating that food, too. They also teach him Japanese. He said, "Now this village is a true home for me. I like visiting new places, but I always enjoy coming back home."

I think the man from India and the people in that village work together to make their lives better. He works for the children there by teaching them English. And the people in that village *care for him. They help him in many ways. The man and the people


Tom: Right. In my class, listening to music is the most popular.

Ms. Wilson: I'm glad that we have nice events in this school.






