- (4) He is rich <u>enough to</u> buy the car.
 - = He is <u>so</u> rich <u>that</u> he can buy the car.
- (5) He has enough money to buy the car.

- (1) He asked me to close the door . (間接話法)
 - 私にドアを閉めるように頼んだ
 - = He said to me, "Please close the door ." (直接話法)
- (2) I <u>told Mike to come here</u> (間接話法)

- = I said to Mike, "Come here ." (直接話法)
- (3) Do you want me to help you?
 - = Shall I help you?
- $E \times 1$. I asked her to wait for an hour.

- I said to her. "Please wait for an hour."
- 2. She asked him to help her .
