

◇ too ... to ~ , ... enough to ~

too 形容詞〔副詞〕 to 不定詞	とても…なので～できない
形容詞〔副詞〕 enough to 不定詞	十分…なので～(できる)

(1) I am too busy to read books.

= I am so busy that I can't read books.

(2) She was too tired to walk.

= She was so tired that she couldn't walk.

(3) This book is too difficult for him to understand.

= This book is so difficult that he can't understand it.

(4) He is rich enough to buy the car.

= He is so rich that he can buy the car.

(5) He has enough money to buy the car.

◇ 間接話法と直接話法

(1) He asked me to close the door. (間接話法)
私にドアを閉めるように頼んだ

= He said to me, "Please close the door." (直接話法)

(2) I told Mike to come here. (間接話法)
マイクにここに来るように言った

= I said to Mike, "Come here." (直接話法)

(3) Do you want me to help you?

= Shall I help you?

Ex 1. I asked her to wait for an hour.
私は彼女に1時間待つように頼んだ。

= I said to her, "Please wait for an hour."

2. She asked him to help her.
彼女は彼に彼女を手伝うように頼んだ。

= She said to him, "Please help me."

3. My father told me to be kind to old people.
私の父は私に年寄りには親切にするように言った。

= My father said to me, "Be kind to old people."

4. He said to me, "Don't open the window."
彼は私に、「その窓を開けるな。」と言いました。

= He told me ~~not~~ to open the window.

5. Do you want me to carry your bag?
(私に) あなたのかばんを運んでほしいですか。

= Shall I carry your bag?
