Almost 20% of the students say, "I don't like the feeling of \*metal or \*leather on my \*skin, so I don't wear a watch." 6% of the students don't even \*check the time. ( ① ) \*I will tell you why.

Now I have two watches. One was my grandfather's watch. He gave it to me when I visited him last summer. It is a really beautiful watch. It has become my treasure because I always remember him when I see the watch.

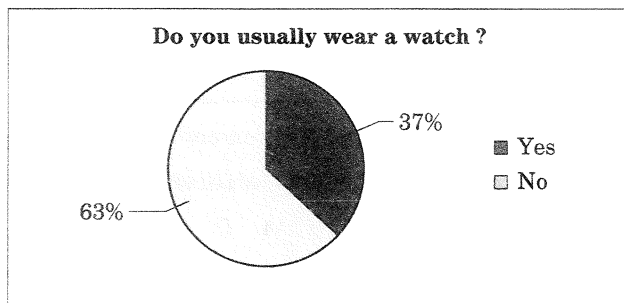

( ③ ) I feel good when I look at such a beautiful thing. And a watch also shows a person's \*character and \*taste to other people.

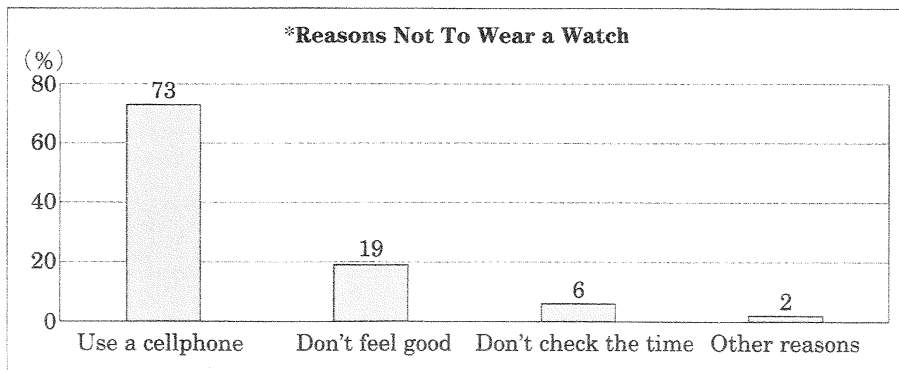
Finally, you don't need to \*charge a watch as often as a cellphone. One of my watches has a \*solar battery in it. If you don't break it,  !

Lucy : Sounds nice. Then you'll change trains at Chuo Station, right ?

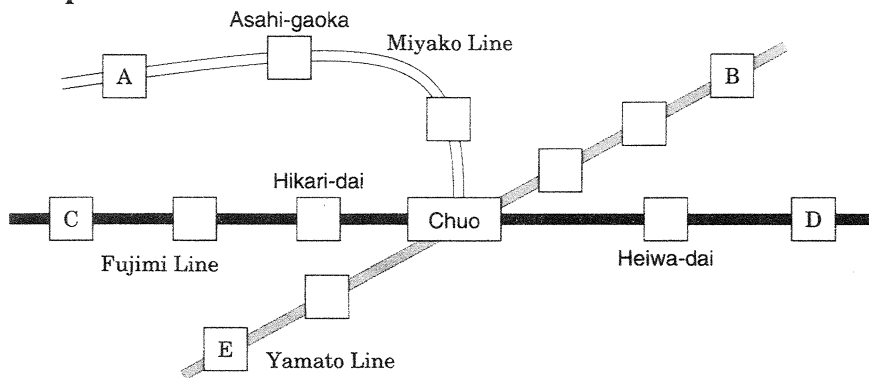
Taku : Yes. How about you, Lucy ?
