- 問3 (ア) 「私はしばしば電車で登校します」 交通手段を表す場合、通常 by を用いる。(イ) 「ケンは今朝からずっと国語を勉強しています」 現在完了進行形は〈have〔has〕been+動詞のing形〉の形で動作の継続を表す。
 (ウ) 「なんて親切な女の子なのでしょう！」 What を用いた感嘆文。〈What(+a(an))+形容詞+名詞!〉
 (エ) 「もし明日暑かったら、私は泳ぎます」「もし～ならば」は接続詞 if で表す。条件を表す副詞節の中では、未来のことも現在形で表す。
- 問4 (ア) Wow, I am glad to hear that! 「わあ、私はそれを聞いてうれしいです！」 〈be glad to+動詞の原形〉で「～してうれしい」。(イ) No, I've never been to a foreign country. 「いいえ、私は一度も外国へ行ったことがありません」「一度も～へ行ったことがない」は have〔has〕never been to ～. I've=I have. (ウ) I'm sorry, but I haven't finished my English homework yet. 「すみませんが、私はまだ英語の宿題を終えていません」 現在完了(完了)の否定文。〈have〔has〕not+過去分詞～yet〉で「まだ～していない」。haven't=have not.
 (エ) My parents often tell me that reading books is very important. 「私の両親はよく私に、本を読むことはとても大切だと言います」「～に…だと言う」は 〈tell+目的語(+that)+主語+動詞～〉で表す。
