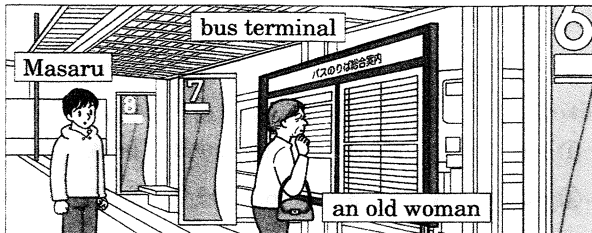

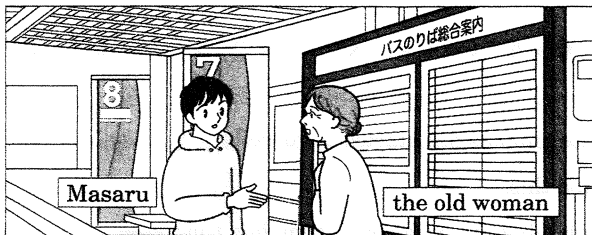

One morning, Masaru saw an old woman at the \*bus terminal. She looked \*troubled.

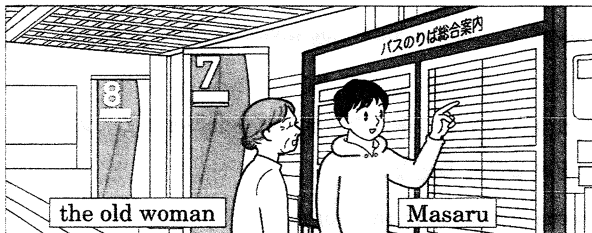

問6 次の英文は、高校生のマミ(Mami)が英語の授業で行った発表の原稿です。英文を読んで、あとの(ア)～(ウ)の問いに答えなさい。

Hello, I'm Mami. What animals do you like? I like \*giant pandas the best. Today I want to talk about these cute animals.

Giant pandas have been on the \*earth for two to three \*million years. No \*wild giant pandas are found in \*other places than China. They live in its \*forests. They sometimes move up to places as high as 4,000 \*meters to look for food. They don't live in groups. ( ① )

A giant panda is a kind of bear. Bears \*are known to sleep \*all through the winter. However, giant pandas don't do that. They just move down to warmer places.

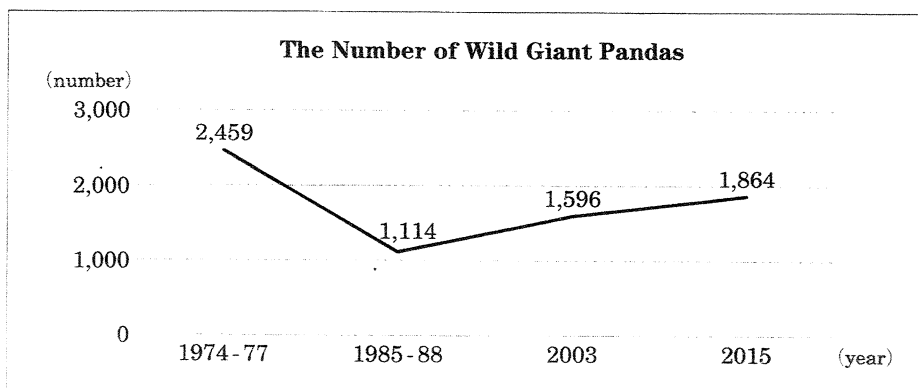
Giant pandas can eat different things. But 99% of their food is bamboo. Giant pandas grow to be 1.5 meters tall and \*weigh 135 \*kilograms. So they need to eat a lot. They eat more than 20 kilograms of bamboo for 15 hours each day!

Giant pandas stay in their mothers for 5 months before they are born. When they are born, they are white and don't have hair. They get their color later. A \*baby is about 15 \*centimeters tall and weighs 150 \*grams, as small as a pencil and only \*one 900th as large as his or her mother. They start to move around when they're 3 months old. After 18 months, they start to live away from their mothers.

A giant panda has a white face and body, but its ears, arms and parts around its eyes are black. What is this for? ( ② )

In the past, many giant pandas were \*killed and sold for their \*fur, sometimes \*for \*up to 10 million yen. Look at this \*graph.

As the graph shows, there were only about 1,100 wild giant pandas in the late 20th century. In giant pandas' forests, new houses, hotels, \*roads and \*railways were built, and then people went there to collect \*herbs. Giant pandas lost their homes quickly. ( ③ )

More than 30 special places for giant pandas were made in China. As the graph shows, wild giant pandas have \*increased \*by 750 these \*past 30 years, and then the number \*rose to 1,864 in 2015. This is a really good sign.  I hope the number of giant pandas continues to increase.

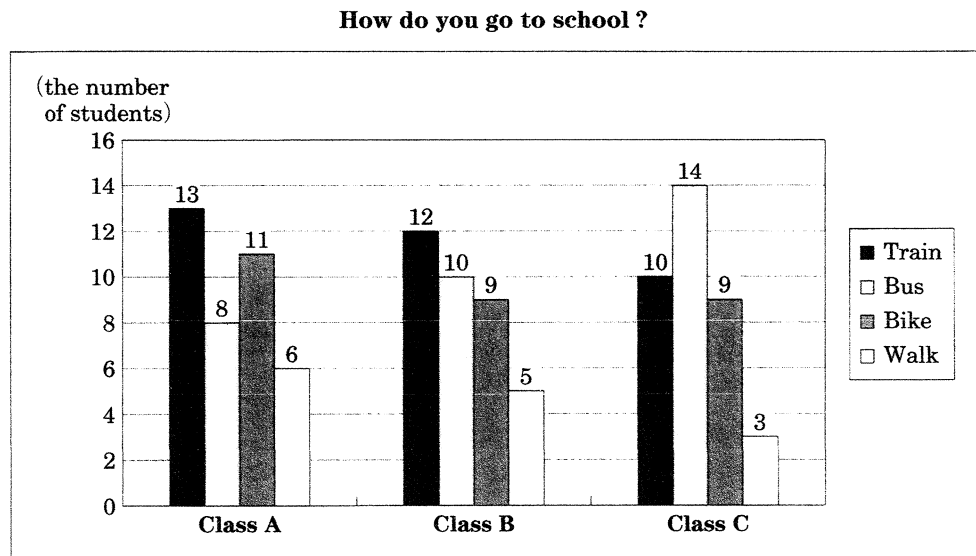
