Taro, Yoko, and a foreign student, John, are members of the English club at their school. They are talking about studying with Ms. Green.

Ms. Green: Today we are going to talk about studying. Why do we study? Taro, can you begin?

Taro: Studying is to learn about something, right? We may think that studying is difficult and boring. However, studying can be interesting if we think we can get new \*knowledge.

Ms. Green: That's right, Taro. If we can study for fun, it gives us the power to study more.

Yoko, what do you think?

Yoko: Well, we can learn about our \*society through studying subjects like social studies, science and Japanese at school. We need such knowledge to be good members of our society. There is a lot of useful information to learn about the world in the school textbooks.

Taro: Yes, Ms. Green. I have a question for everyone in the club. What do you want to be in the future? What kind of job do you want to do? I haven't decided yet. However, I think that we need to study to look for our \*goal in the future. If you don't have a goal now, that's OK. When the time comes, you may find your goal. I think studying can give us a good chance to think about our future.

Ms. Green: That's true, Taro. I'll give you some words about studying now. When I was a student, I just studied and didn't think that it was so important. However, when I looked back, I was surprised to find that study helped me a lot. So, if you study now, you can take more courses in the future. However, if you don't study now, the door to your future may close. Young people like you have great \*potential.

Yoko: When we study, we can get important \*abilities for our lives. Before we study, we

usually make plans. Learning something also needs a lot of \*attention. And studying often comes with \*difficulties, so we must be \*patient. Studying can give us such good abilities. You may think math or English won't be useful to your future, but we can learn other important things when we study those subjects.

Ms. Green: Thank you very much. We talked a lot about studying today. I hope that now you have a good reason to study.
