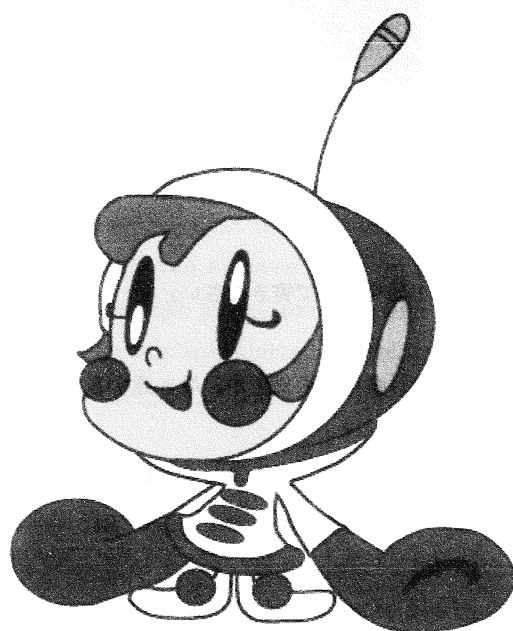


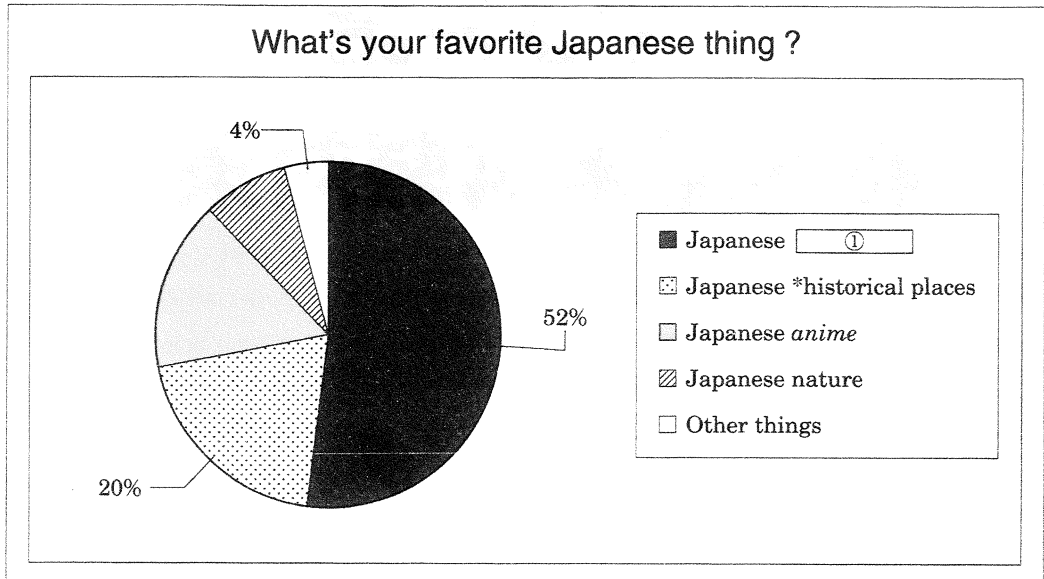

1 2. 高校生の美和(Miwa)が, “My Precious Memory” (私の大切な思い出)というタイトルで, 次の英文を書きました。これを読んで, あとの問いに答えなさい。

Last June, when I was a junior high school student, I was thinking about my dream for the future. I sometimes talked with my mother, so I knew what she thought about it. I wanted to talk with my father, too, but he was very busy then. So I could not find time to talk with him. I sometimes felt that he was not interested in what I wanted to do in the
5 future. I was a little sad about it.

Soon after my summer vacation started in July, my father came home from work and said to me, “Miwa, I’d like to *climb Mt. Fuji this summer. Will you come with me?” I was surprised at his words, but I was glad because he found time for me. Then my father said, “You can climb it. It will be a great memory.” He told me about his plan. I thought
10 it would be wonderful to be at the top of the highest mountain in Japan, so I agreed.

One day, next month, we got to *the fifth station of Mt. Fuji by bus. There were so many people there. It was cloudy that day. I hoped it would be fine.

We started to climb at about one o’clock in the afternoon. Soon I found many people were walking fast. I said to my father, “Shall we walk faster?” Then he said, “No, Miwa.
15 We don’t have to walk fast. Just keep walking, then we will get to the top.”

After about thirty minutes, he said, “Let’s stop here, but don’t sit down.” I was surprised to hear that. Then he said, “If we sit down, we won’t want to stand up again. We will stop for a few minutes many times until we get to the top.” So we stopped without sitting down. After a few minutes, we started walking again.

20 When we came to a point between the seventh and the eighth stations, I was getting very tired. It was getting colder, too. I sat down and said to my father, “I’m very tired and cannot walk any more. I want to go down.” Then my father said, “I know you are very tired after walking hard. I’m tired, too. But we have already walked a long way. If you keep walking, you can get to the *goal. Never give up.” I was very tired, but his
25 words moved something in me. I thought, “I should not give up here.” Then we started climbing again.

We got to the *mountain hut at the eighth station at about six o’clock in the evening. There were many people in the hut. We ate curry and rice, and then went to bed.

The next morning we left the hut at one o’clock to see the *sunrise at the top of Mt.
30 Fuji. I saw many stars in the sky and knew that it was going to be a fine day.

After we climbed for more than three hours, we got to our goal. “Here we are, Miwa. You’ve made it! You will see the sunrise soon.” Then the sun was coming out. It was so beautiful. My father said to me, “You said you wanted to go down, but you have got to the top because you kept walking. I know you are thinking about your future. ”
35 Then I understood why he climbed Mt. Fuji with me. I felt I learned something

important. I thanked him and Mt. Fuji for giving me a precious memory in my life.
