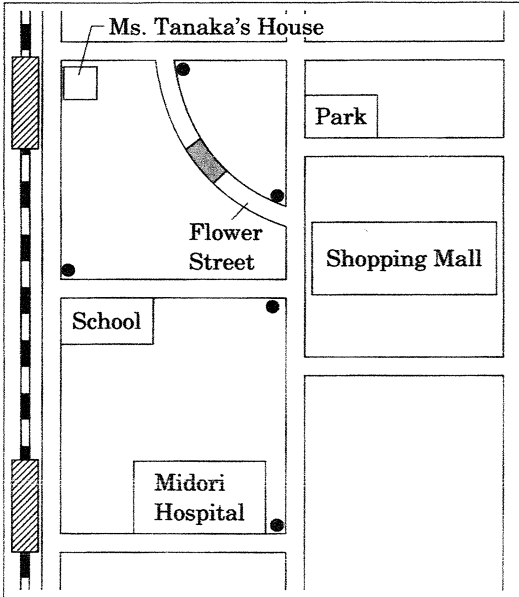
(イ)

Ms. Tanaka has a few things to do today. She'll leave her house and move to some places by using **transportation*.




First, Ms. Tanaka will go to Midori Hospital to see her grandmother. The hospital is **a* five-minute walk from the nearest station, so she'll go there by train. Next, she wants to buy some warm clothes and winter **goods* because it has been cold recently. She'll go from the hospital to the **shopping* mall by bus. After that, she'll go back to her house. She usually uses Flower Street because it's a **shortcut* to her house. However, it's now **under construction*. So she has to use another way. The **distance* between the shopping mall and her house is **almost* 2 **km*. She can use a bus, but she may have a lot of **baggage*, so she'll use a **taxi*.
