



Hello, everyone. I'm Shinji. It's fall now. We say "*Dokusho no Aki*." I enjoy reading books every day.

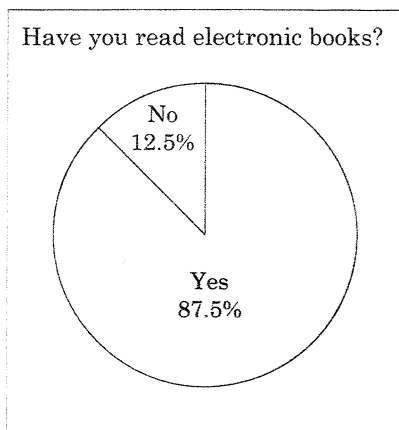
I think you sometimes buy books. Do you usually buy a book at a bookstore or on the Internet? I usually buy books at bookstores. I have some reasons to do so. We can usually "browse a little at bookstores. It's important for me because I want to read the "contents a little before buying books. Also, there are a lot of books at bookstores, so we sometimes find interesting books "by chance. I have found some of my favorite books by chance at bookstores.

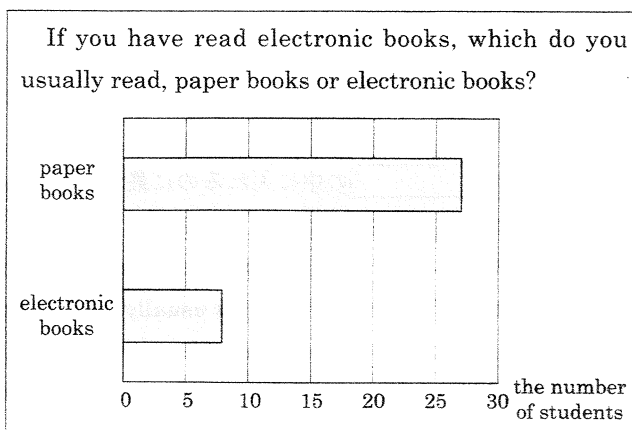
I like to be in a place like a bookstore or a library, but now, the number of bookstores in Japan "is decreasing "year by year. I feel a little sad to hear that. Today, more and more people buy books on the Internet. I sometimes buy a book on the Internet when I can't find the book at bookstores. When we buy books on the Internet, we don't have to go to a bookstore. (②) Also, it's easier to find a book on the Internet. When we buy a book at a bookstore, we sometimes look for the book at the bookstore for a long time. I can understand many people buy books on the Internet because it's "convenient.

"By the way, we can read "electronic books by using a "tablet device or a "smartphone today. I have read a story by using my smartphone before. I asked my classmates a question about electronic books. There are 40 students in my class "except me. "Graph 1 shows the answer to the question. 87.5% of my classmates answered "Yes". Then, I asked them the second question. Graph 2 shows the answer to the second question.

From Graph 1 and Graph 2, we can see that most of my classmates have read electronic books, .

I read paper books. If we buy paper books, we can "lend and borrow the books each other.

(③) I think I can remember the story better when I read paper books than when I read

electronic books. And I feel a little happy to touch a paper book and to see my favorite books on my *bookshelf.

But electronic books have some good points, too. First, we need the *spaces for paper books, but we don't need the spaces for electronic books. Second, we can usually buy electronic books at a little more *reasonable price than paper books because paper is not needed to make electronic books. Third, paper books will become old and *dirty, but electronic books won't. I think electronic books will become more and more popular in the future.

We can buy and read books in some ways today. I think it's good for us to have some *choices about books. I think each person should read books *in the way he or she likes. Thank you for listening today.
