問3 適語選択

- (ア) この before は前置詞なので、あとに動詞を置く場合は動名詞にします。よって、having があてはまります。
 (イ) 英文は「私は3年間兄と会っていません」という意味だと考えられます。「～の間」と、どのくらいの期間であるかを表す場合は、for を使います。
 (ウ) if ～「もし～なら」と言うときは、未来のことでも現在形を使って表します。よって、rains があてはまります。rainy は形容詞であり、be 動詞とともに用いるのであてはまりません。
 (エ) 「～されている」と言うときは、過去分詞を使います。よって、spoken があてはまります。

問4 語順整序

- (ア) AさんはBさんに「あなたのクラスには何人の女子がいますか？」と聞いたと考えられます。「何人の～」とたずねるときは How many ～で表すので、正解となる文は、(How) many girls are there in (your class?) です。
 (イ) AさんはBさんに「その建物は、いつ建てられるでしょうか」と聞いたと考えられます。動詞は受け身＜be 動詞＋過去分詞＞で表し、未来のことをたずねるので、正解となる文は (When) will the building be built (?) です。
 (ウ) AさんはBさんに「あなたは何かよいことがあったのですか」と言ったと考えられます。「何か～なこと」は something(anything) ～で表しますが、ここでは疑問文なので anything を使います。よって、正解は Did you have anything good (?) です。
 (エ) BさんはAさんに宿題が終わったか聞かれて、「まだです。しかし、宿題を終えるのは難しいと思います」と言ったと考えられます。よって、正解は (But I don't think) it is difficult to finish (it.) です。
