



Yes, I know them. But the one across the street from the park is *expensive. The other two are better.

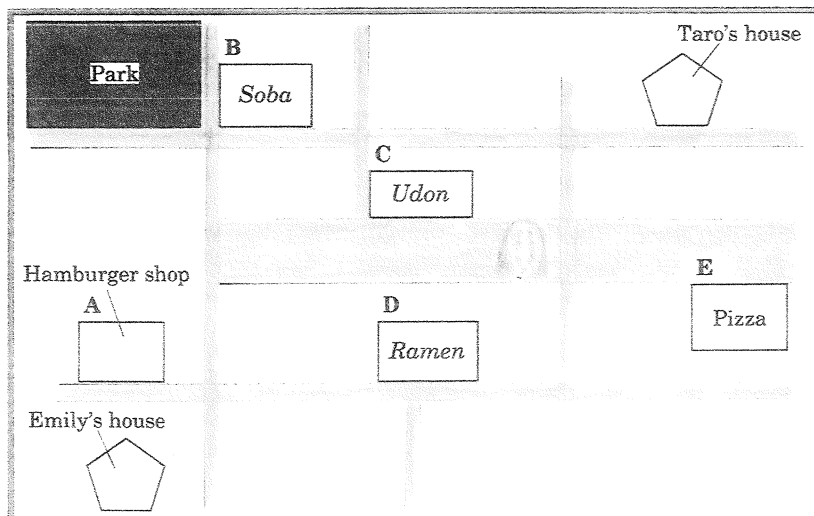
Taro
