## 問3 適語選択

(7) 「私が帰宅したとき,私の姉 [妹] はテレビを見ていました。」という文だと考えられます。過去のある時点で進行中だった動作は,be 動詞の過去形  $+\sim$  ing の過去進行形で表します。よって,2 の was watching があてはまります。

- (イ) 「最初、マイクはその箱をどこへ置いたらよいかわからなかったので、それを机の上に置くことに決めました。」 という文だと考えられます。疑問詞 + to +動詞の原形はひとまとまりで名詞の働きをし、know や tell などの動詞 の目的語として使われます。「どこへ~したらよいか」は where to +動詞の原形で表します。よって、1 の where があてはまります。
- (ウ) 「コウタと私はきのうテレビゲームをすることを楽しみました。」という文だと考えられます。enjoy の目的語に動詞がくる場合は、動名詞の形で表します。よって、3の playing があてはまります。
- (エ) 「私は今朝起きるのが遅かったので、まだ朝食を食べていません。」という文だと考えられます。現在完了の完了 用法の否定文で「まだ(~していません)」と表す場合は、文末に yet を置きます。よって、4 の yet があてはまり ます。

## 問 4 語順整序

- (7) A さんが「あなたに私の新しい自転車を見せましょう。」と述べていることに対して、B さんは「おお、それはかっこいいですね。」と述べていると考えられます。「 $\sim$  (人) に… (もの) を見せる」は show + + もので表します。よって、正解となる英文は、(I) will show you my new (bike.) です。不要語は to です。
- (ウ) A さんが「私には3か国語を話す友達がいます。」と述べていることに対して、B さんは「本当ですか。私は自分の英語を上達させるために、もっと熱心に勉強します。」と述べていると考えられます。「私には友達がいる」は I have a friend と表します。「3か国語を話す友達」というまとまりを作るために、friend のあとに主格の関係代名詞who を置いて修飾します。who のあとには動詞がくるので、speaks three languages を続けます。動詞の形は先行詞 a friend に合わせるので、三人称単数の s がつく speaks になります。よって、正解となる英文は、(I have a) friend who speaks three languages (.) です。不要語は speak です。
- (エ) A さんが「あなたのクラスではだれがいちばん速く走りますか。」とたずねていることに対して、B さんは「リクトです。私は彼ほど速く走ることができません。」と答えていると考えられます。「私は速く走ることはできません」は I can't run fast と表します。「~ほど…ない」は not as + 原級 + as ~と表します。よって、正解となる英文は、I can't run as fast (as he.) です。不要語は faster です。
