



問6 次の英文は、高校生のスグル（Suguru）が英語の授業で行った発表の原稿です。英文を読んで、あとの(ア)～(ウ)の問いに答えなさい。

Hi, everyone. December has come. It has been cold, but do you remember that it was really hot this summer? It was over 40 °degrees in some cities in Japan. In August, I watched the high school baseball *tournament at Koshien Stadium on TV, and it was exciting, but I worried about the players because it was really hot this summer. I hear it was also very hot in other countries. (①)

Look at *Table. It shows *monthly average maximum temperature (*abbreviated to 'MAMT') in Tokyo. From Table, we can see that .


You know, we are going to have Tokyo *Olympic and Paralympic Games in 2020. (②) If it is as hot as this summer, I think it will be *harsh for *athletes, especially, *marathon runners.

I thought, "Has Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games ever been held in a hot place?" Then, I *looked it up on the Internet. It hasn't been held in the city in the *tropical regions. It has been held in a lot of cities like London and Sydney. It is cooler in London than in Tokyo, and Sydney is in the *southern hemisphere, so in Sydney, it's winter in July and August. If it becomes much warmer on the earth, I think we should have Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games in a 'cooler city' like London. We had Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games in Tokyo in 1964, but it was held in October and November.

I hear the *International Olympic Committee is thinking about *measures for the *heat. The members of it decided to start *marathon race in the early morning. I think it's a good idea.

Many foreign people will come to see Tokyo Olympic and Paralympic Games. I don't think most of them understand Japanese. So we should think about the things we can do for them. I learned an interesting thing on the Internet. Look at Picture. It shows a part of a *communication support board which *ambulance crews use for foreign people. (③)
